COVID-19 (CORONAVIRUS) UPDATE INTERNATIONAL SCHOOL OF RIGA

Dear ISR community.

I'm writing to you today with another update on the COVID-19 (coronavirus) situation, and how it impacts ISR.

Today, France, Germany, Spain, Austria and Switzerland have been added to an already established list of countries (Italy, Singapore, Japan, Iran, South Korea and China) that have been deemed by medical and governmental authorities in Latvia as high-risk areas for contracting the virus. These authorities have asked that people in Latvia do not travel to said countries and that if you are returning from one of them, to self-quarantine for a period of 14 days, and then obtain medical clearance.

As previously communicated, ISR faculty and staff who have traveled to any of these aforementioned areas are being instructed to remain at home and return to work only after 14 days with medical clearance.

Additionally, we are instructing any students who have travelled to any of these areas during the past 14 days to remain at home for 14 days and only return after obtaining medical clearance. We ask all parents to comply with this request, not because it is the law, but because it is the responsible thing to do in the best interest of the entire School community.

We are also asking any parents who have travelled to any of these areas during the past 14 days to not enter School premises for a period of 14 days and only do so after obtaining medical clearance.

ISR continues to implement conservative precautionary measures to ensure that we are acting responsibly in our duty of care to our children, and the greater ISR community.
