NEW CORONAVIRUS UPDATE INTERNATIONAL SCHOOL OF RIGA

Greetings ISR Community.

The Latvian Crisis Management Council posted the following at 9:10pm this evening. ([HERE](#))

"Children returning from coronavirus-affected countries and territories subject to special precautions must spend 14 days at home. The child can then go to an educational institution with a certificate from a family doctor certifying that the child is healthy. If, however, symptoms of the disease do occur, a telephone call should be made. 113."

Therefore, all students who travelled to one of the countries listed below **MUST NOT** attend school for 14 days.

China, South Korea, Iran, Lombardy and Veneto in Italy

Families are also required to present a certificate from their family doctor to the school before children return.

This is no longer a recommendation. It is a mandate from a Latvian Government Health Authority and therefore must be adhered to by everyone in the ISR community.
