Greetings ISR community.

First I would like to use this opportunity to inform the community that today the State Medical Emergency Commission, from February 28th, has implemented special precautionary measures for persons who have returned from:

- the regions of Lombardy, Veneto, Emilia-Romagna, Piedmont, Italy
- Japan
- Singapore
- South Korea
- Iran
- China

Therefore, if any students have travelled to any of these countries/regions recently, they are to stay at home and return to school only when they have been granted a clearance certificate from their family doctor.

As we are aware of the locations that the students have travelled to over the break, we are able to manage the situation.

We continue to monitor temperatures of all students, faculty and staff each day. Regardless of travel history, we must insist that if your child has a temperature above 37.5 C you do not send them to school.

Finally, formal communications such as these will be sent solely from the ISR administration, school nurse(s) or Head of Child Protection, Mr Tony Rialland. No other communication should be considered accurate and you are asked to communicate directly with the aforementioned people so we may reduce the risk of miscommunication and/or the spreading of counterproductive rumours.
