Greetings ISR community.

Thank you to everyone who took the time to complete the survey regarding the possibility of moving the upcoming Spring Break. Based on input from teachers, students and parents, it is clear that this move is overwhelmingly preferred by the ISR community.

Therefore, the upcoming Spring Break will move from **April 10th-17th** to **April 6th-13th** with the hope that we return to school on April 14th as currently planned by the government. If the government extends the Distance Learning Programming (DLP) past April 14th, this change will still support a more balanced schedule between DLP and breaks/holidays.

Additionally, starting **Saturday, March 28th**, the K118 campus will be closed to all ISR students and parents. All Preschool, Kindergarten and Grade 1 students will move fully to the DLP. ISR has tried to be very accommodating for parents of younger children to search for childcare options over the past two weeks. However, it is time that we further increase our ongoing commitment towards reducing the spread of COVID-9 and better protect our entire community by all learning and working from home.
