Summary for School Council meeting on April 27, 2026

On April 27th, 2026, a regular School Council meeting took place at Skanstes 27 and Zoom. Quorum was confirmed, and the minutes from the January 26th and March 9th meetings were approved.

Amanda Romey (AR) presented admissions and Director's updates. The April Open House had 13 registrations and 11 attendees, with more Open Houses planned for May and June. For 2026–2027, 246 students have re-enrolled, 12 withdrawals have been submitted, and 30 new students have been admitted, with 30 more applications in process. The Council discussed following up carefully with undecided families and those leaving, especially where relocation or personal circumstances may be involved.

AR also reported that ISR has received MYP authorization, with five commendations, no matters to address, and four recommendations for the next review cycle. The Council thanked the Board and Faculty for their work. Student wellbeing, safety procedures, and the development of a new phone use policy were also discussed, with ISR moving towards becoming a phone-free school next year.

Kristīne Daktere (KD) presented financial and operational updates, mainly focused on marketing and enrollment growth. Marketing will include updated photo and video content, alumni and family testimonials, and direct outreach to embassies, international organizations, chambers of commerce, and companies.

Operational updates included the handover of the V9 premises, furniture delivery, and ongoing staffing challenges, especially for native-level French and Spanish teachers. The Council also agreed that another formal letter should be prepared with legal support regarding the unresolved issue with the Skanstes 43 property.

The Child Protection Committee did not present a detailed report, but student wellbeing, safeguarding, emergency planning, and safety procedures remain ongoing priorities.
