Summary for School Council meetings in March 2026.

On March 9th, 2026, a regular School Council meeting took place at Skanstes 27 and Zoom. The quorum was confirmed.

Amanda Romey (AR) presented admissions updates. Applications for the upcoming academic year continue to arrive, with a diverse international applicant pool. AR then presented the Director's Report, focusing on academic and operational developments. Results from a recent student and staff survey were positive, particularly regarding teacher preparedness, classroom organization, and assessment fairness. AR also shared updates on curriculum review, staffing needs, and upcoming school events.

Kristīne Daktere (KD) presented the proposed budget for the 2026–2027 academic year. The Council unanimously approved the proposed budget and fees to be presented at the upcoming AGM.

Continuing with the Governance Committee, members discussed preparations for the AGM later in March. The Council also supported stronger alumni engagement and clear communication protocols for parent concerns.

The March 9th meeting ended with updates from the Child Protection Committee. AR reported continued cooperation with relevant authorities and embassies to support security procedures when needed. Emergency and relocation procedures were reviewed.

On March 25th, 2026, the Annual General Meeting took place online through Zoom and the ElectionBuddy platform. During the Director's Report, AR shared updates on campus development, including outdoor play area improvements, a new early years classroom, and the renovated library. Student life updates included close to 100 field trips, school productions, strong participation in after-school activities, sports achievements, and 100% IB Diploma success for the previous Grade 12 cohort. KD presented the Financial Report, explaining that ISR remains in a strong financial position, although the new secondary campus expansion has increased fixed costs.

The School Council Report was presented by IK, VG, HK, and IB. The report outlined the Council's role, committee structure, and work during the year, including support for goal setting, policy review, MYP accreditation, five-year financial projections, admissions monitoring, and campus development. The Facilities Committee highlighted investment in the primary campus and the opening of the new secondary campus, while the Child Protection Committee reported on policy review, security improvements, Kiva anti-bullying work, training, and psychological support.

Voting results confirmed that both the Annual Financial Statements for 2025 and the School Year 2026–2027 tuition fees were approved.
